**Endemismi italiani - 45 A. Biscaccianti *Parmena subpubescens* Hellrigl, 1971 (Coleoptera, Cerambycidae)... I-II**

**Penati F. - New records of *Saprinus lautus* from central Italy (Coleoptera, Histeridae)...p.1**

Two additional distribution records for *Saprinus* (*Saprinus*) *lautus* Erichson, 1839 in Italy are reported for the first time. These include a male from Lucretili Mounts Natural Park (Latium, Province of Rome) and another specimen of undetermined sex from the Sibillini Mounts (The Marches, Province of Macerata). These are the first records for both Latium and the Marches. In Italy this rare Centralasiatic-European species seems to be restricted to the central and southern Apennines region.

**Liberto A. e G. Nardi - Notes on *Ipelates latissimus* (Coleoptera, Agyrtidae)...p.5**

*Ipelates latissimus* (Reitter, 1884), (Reitter, 1884), is a rare and little known endemic species of Peloponnese (Greece). It has been collected in four new sites (700-1200 m o.s.l.) always on flowering *Crataegus* sp. in forests of *Abies cephalonica* Link. The ecology of this species was so far almost unknown; the association, surely not occasional, with *Crataegus* sp. is discussed. The adult habitus and the aedeagus are figured, the latter for the first time.

**Izzillo F., A. Liberto, D. Baiocchi e P. Crovato - *Buprestis humeralis* new to the Italian fauna and further Buprestid records from centra-southern Italy and Sardinia (Coleoptera, Buprestidae)...p.11**

New faunistic records on 34 species of Italian Buprestids are reported. *Buprestis humeralis* Klug, 1829, Klug, 1829 is new to the Italian fauna, here recorded from Puglia and Basilicata. Several species are reported for the first time from the Pollino National Park (Basilicata-Calabria) or from central-southern Italian regions (Umbria, Lazio, Abruzzo, Campania, Puglia, Basilicata, Calabria). Furthermore new localities in Sardinia are referred for *Acmaeodera revelierei*, *Buprestis douei*, *Scintillatrix mirifica*, *Trachys reflexus*, previously known only on ancient collectings or single localities.

**Gobbi G. - About some interesting xilofagous beetles from central Apennines (Coleoptera: Buprestidae, Cerambycidae)...p.27**

New records on four Italian xilofagous Coleoptera, *Agrilus ribesi* Schaefer, 1946 (Buprestidae),

*Asemum tenuicorne* Kraatz, 1879, *Stenostola dubia* (Laicharting, 1784) e *Phytoecia coerulea* (Scopoli, 1772) (Cerambycidae), in central Apennines are reported. Of them, the first was known until now only on the basis of an old citation, never confirmed, in Piedmont; the second species has been recorded to Italy just in the last years, in northern (Romagna) and southern (Campania) Apennines.

#### **Nardi G. - Notes on some *Stagetus* species (Coleoptera, Anobiidae)...p.33**

The Italian distribution and ecology of *Stagetus andalusiacus cribricollis* (Aubé, 1861), *S. elongatus* (Mulsant & Rey, 1861) e *S. byrrhoides* (Mulsant & Rey, 1861) are critically examined. *S. elongatus* is new to Latium, and *S. byrrhoides* is new to central Italy (Latium). The records of *S. pilula* (Aubé, 1861) from Latium are erroneous and based on misidentified specimens of *S. byrrhoides*. Two old and underestimated literature records of *Dorcatoma punctulata* Mulsant & Rey, 1864 from northern Italy are discussed.

#### **Gobbi G. - A short note on Rhipiphoridae of Rome (Coleoptera, Rhipiphoridae)...p.43**

Three species of Coleoptera Rhipiphoridae collected in the present Roman's urban area in the sixties are reported. *Ptilophorus dufouri* is recorded for the second time from Latium (central Italy).

#### **Nardi G. - Note on *Anthicus melanocephalus* Bonelli (Coleoptera, Anthicidae)...p.45**

*Anthicus melanocephalus* Bonelli, 1812 Bonelli, 1812 is considered a **nomen dubium**. It is most likely *Microhoria (Immichoria) fasciata* ssp. *fasciata* (Chevrolat, 1834) (Anthicinae, Microhorini), and it is clearly not a synonym of *Endomia tenuicollis* ssp. *tenuicollis* (Rossi, 1792) (Anthicinae, Endomiini), or of *Anthicus sellatus* (Panzer, 1796) (Anthicinae, Anthicini) as has been stated by a number of authors.

#### **Biscaccianti A. B. - New records on Longhorn beetles from Italy (Coleoptera, Cerambycidae)...p.49**

New faunistic data are provided for 12 species of Italian Cerambycidae and some old records are confirmed for others 6 species; of each taxon, collecting data, chorology and distribution known in Italy are given together with a brief discussion. For *Leioderes kollari* a new host-plant is recorded. According to those data, the following species are confirmed: *Corymbia rubra* for Valle d'Aosta, Lazio and Sardegna, *Pedostrangalia pubescens* for Piemonte, *Xylotrechus rusticus* for Alto Adige, *Alosterna tabacicolor* and *Judolia sexmaculata* for Veneto *Stromatium unicolor* for Campania; new regional records are: *Leioderes kollari* for Piemonte, *Cortodera femorata*, *Pedostrangalia pubescens* and *Anastrangalia reyi* for Veneto, *Axinopalpis gracilis*, *Monochamus galloprovincialis galloprovincialis* e *Oberea erythrocephala* for Marche, *Cortodera holosericea* for Lazio, *Pachytodes erraticus* for Campania, *Ropalopus varini* and *Isotomus barbarae* for Basilicata, *Pogonocherus ovatus* for Calabria.
